



# Northeast North Carolina Medical Reserve Corps

## MEMBERSHIP AT-A-GLANCE

The Northeast North Carolina Medical Reserve Corps (NENC MRC) is a collaborative partnership between many agencies in Northeastern North Carolina. The primary sponsoring agencies are Albemarle Regional Health Services, the Martin Tyrrell Washington Health District, Hertford County Public Health Authority, and Hyde County Department of Public Health, Dare County Department of Public Health. The public health agencies have joined forces to coordinate a 13-county Medical Reserve Corps to meet the community needs in public health and medical emergencies. The 13 counties these five health departments cover are as follows: **Bertie, Camden, Chowan, Currituck, Dare, Gates, Hertford, Hyde, Martin, Pasquotank, Perquimans, Tyrrell, and Washington.** Other key partner agencies include The Greater Albemarle Area Chapter of the American Red Cross, area hospitals, county emergency management, and the Eastern Region MRC.

**The mission of the Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) is to improve the health and safety of communities across the country by organizing and utilizing public health, medical, and other volunteers.**

### NENC MRC Responder Requirements

#### Application Process:

- Interest Form submitted to MRC Coordinator
- Phone Interview/ Process Review
- ServNC.org Application
- Valid Identification
- License and Certificate Verification
- Service/ Confidentiality Waivers

#### Active Responder Requirements:

- 18 years of age
- Training (see below)
- Participate in at least two activities per calendar year through MRC or responder agency (training, community activity, or exercise)

#### Training Opportunities:

- Orientation (Required)
- ICS 100 (Required)
- ICS 700 (Required)
- Basic Life Support (CPR & First Aide) (Required)
- MRC Response Overview (Required)
- ICS 200, 300, 400, 800
- Community Outreach
- Psychological First Aid and Mental Health
- Emergency and Risk Communication
- Joint Information Systems
- Other

#### Service Activities:

- Community Outreach
- Community Support
- Medical Surge

#### Types of Volunteers:

The NENC MRC needs all types of volunteers, not just medical volunteers!!!

- Physicians
- Electricians
- Plumbers
- Health Educators
- Carpenters
- Others

#### Deployment Overview:

- Emergency Management must request responders
- AT NO TIME SHOULD ANY MEMBER SELF DEPLOY
- All deployments will be coordinated through the MRC Director/Coordinator or his/her designee

#### Dismissal:

- A member may be dismissed immediately for:
  - failure or refusal to fulfill assignment expectations;
  - misconduct;
  - civil or criminal violations; or
  - other, as deemed by the NENC MRC Advisory Council.
- Upon dismissal equipment and unused supplies must be returned or the individual will be billed
